



SITE RULES - ALL USERS

LEADERS PLEASE READ - IMPORTANT

Site Curfew - NO noise is permitted before 7am or after 10pm.

The Orchard - activities are NOT permitted in this area.(only archery when accompanied by a Girlguiding Wirral Instructor)

The Cottage & Orchard Shelter, the Car Park and Cedar Camp Site are all very close to our neighbours so please be considerate and conscious of how noise can travel. There is a Restrictive Covenant (Court Order) cover this area of Hadlow that is held by our neighbours, which as a site user you are required to adhere to. Your warden will explain full details on arrival.

All sites should be quiet between 10pm and 7am.

ACTIVITIES - All activities should be listed on your booking form at the time of booking. Please be aware that activities involving amplified music, shooting (except archery under instruction from GGW instructor) or motorised vehicles are not permitted on the site.

ON SITE ACTIVITIES - Leaders must be familiar with the Conditions of Use Policy and Risk Assessments for the onsite activities before allowing youth members to use them.

CAMPSITE SHELTERS - tables, buckets, brush / rake, incinerator and bin should be in your shelter. Please leave shelters in a clean and tidy condition with all rubbish removed to the bins at the bottom of the drive. If anything is missing from your shelter please report it to your warden.

EQUIPMENT - All equipment either hired or borrowed should be returned to Warden in a clean and functioning condition at the end of your stay, please report any faults to us.

FIRES - Fires should not be built directly on the ground. All equipment to build alter fires is stored in Mole Hill Shelter near the Ice House. Please ensure that all grates, metal sheets and bricks are returned and stacked neatly in Mole Hill. An adult must be present when fires are being used and water buckets should be used. There are two campfire circles at the top of the camping field, either side of the Adventure Playground please use these for your group campfires. Please leave campfire areas tidy. Ashes can be scattered in the woods when cold.

FRIDGE / FREEZER - These are in Ice House and site labels are available. Please ensure you have emptied and wiped out fridges out before leaving.

RUBBISH - Incinerators are provided on all sites. The rubbish bins are located at the bottom of the drive. Please bag waste before placing it in the black lid bin. Glass, tins, paper, cardboard and plastic can be recycled so please place this in the green lid bin.

TOILET BLOCK - The toilet block is open between 7am and 10pm. Campers will need to bring portable loos for night time. The emptying point is in the Ladies toilets. Please ensure all campers know that personal hygiene products, face wipes or food is not to be flushed down the toilets. The washing of cooking equipment or dishes is not permitted in the toilet block.

TROLLEYS - These should be returned to the shelter on Orchard once you have finished using them so other campers can make use of them. They must not be ridden on.

VEHICLES - All vehicles should be parked on the car park. Cars are not permitted on the camping field unless with the express permission of the warden. Cottage users may load and unload vehicles at the rear of the cottage before immediately returning them to the car park.

WOOD - Please make use of fallen wood across the site. Please ensure camper know not to climb or damage the trees. All wood must be returned to woodpile. Please ensure an adult accompanies campers when at the woodpile. Beware of nails and no climbing on woodpile.
